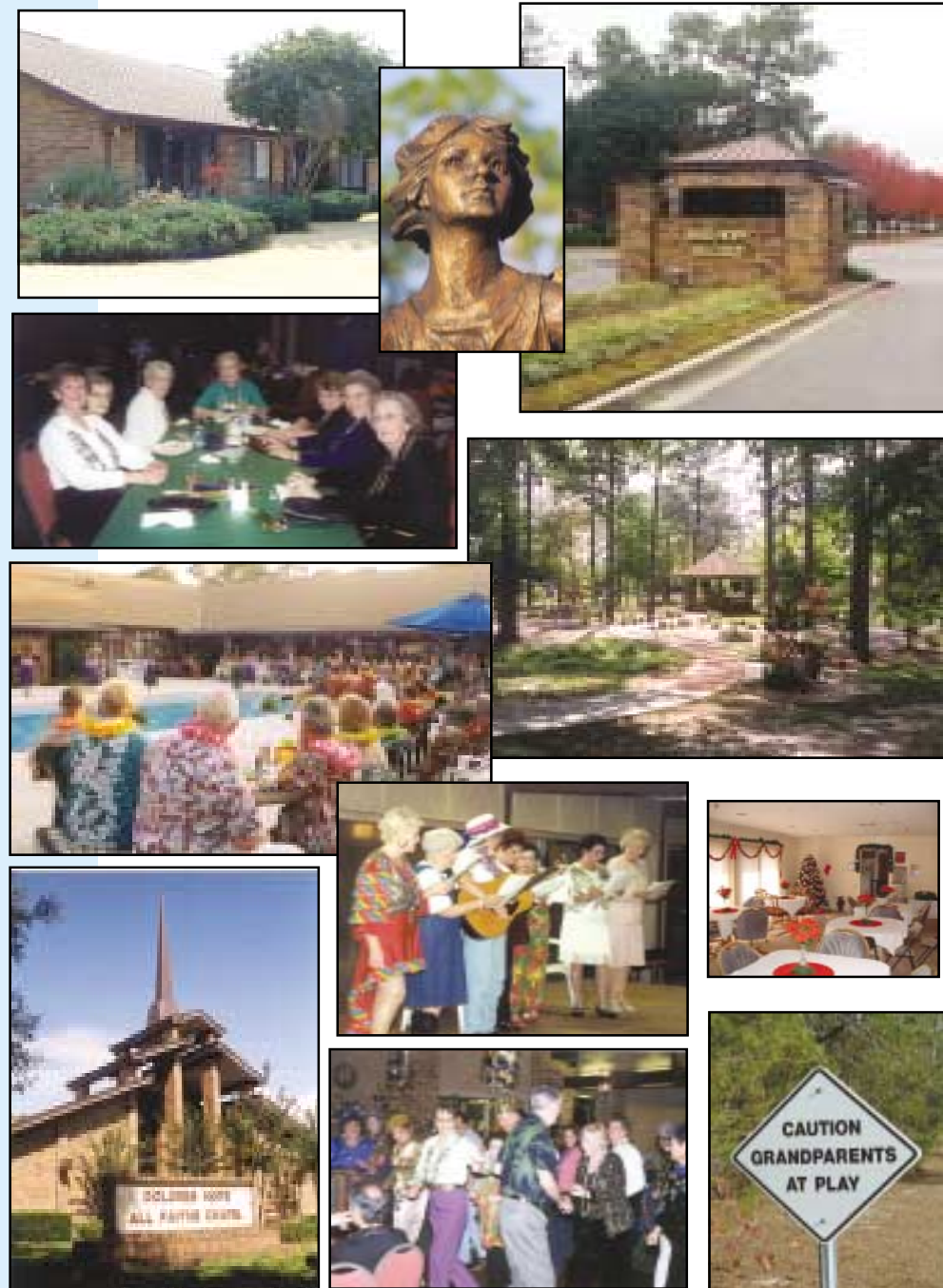


Bob Hope Village, 92 Sunset Lane, Shalimar, FL 32579-1000

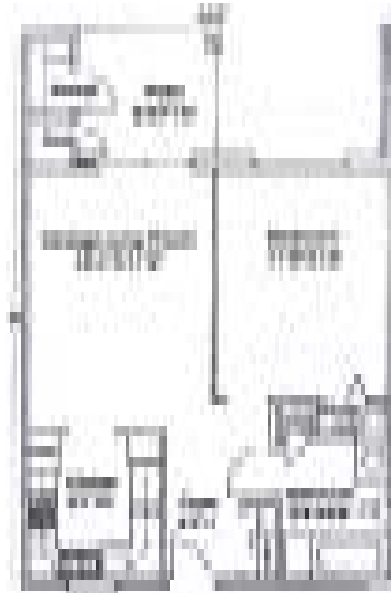
Capacity: 32 two-bedroom and 224 one-bedroom garden apartments.

Emergency Call System: An emergency medical alert system is available to residents.

The Bob Hope Village Community Center is 29,000 square feet and houses a dining room and kitchen; gift shop; arts and crafts room; beauty salon; game room and library. There is an outdoor swimming pool and hot tub as well. The Dolores Hope All Faiths Chapel seats 200 and stands majestically on the Bob Hope Village campus. Guests marvel at the natural aesthetic beauty outside and inside the chapel as well as the adjacent Garden of Hope and Bob Gates Welcome Center. A 1½-mile nature trail weaves through the natural landscape with picnic tables and benches along the way for rest stops.

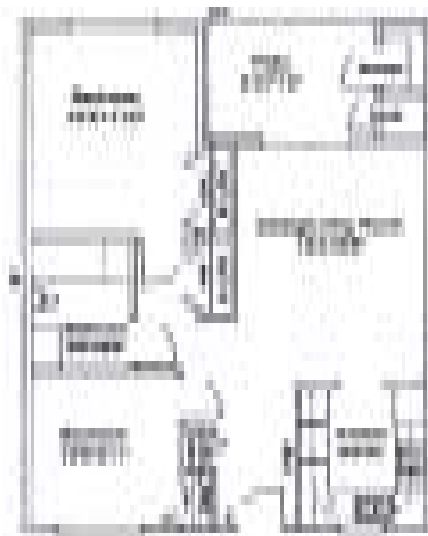


**Bob Hope Village Floor Plans

About the Village

Purpose: The primary mission of the Air Force Enlisted Village is to provide the surviving spouses of Air Force retired enlisted members with housing facilities and related services. "Air Force" includes Air Force Reserve and Air National Guard enlisted members.

Additionally the AFEV provides the same services and facilities to retired Air Force enlisted couples and to dependent parents of active duty and retired members.

Principles: The Board of Directors, in fulfilling the Village's purpose, adheres to the following guidelines:

1. No discrimination on the basis of sex, race, color, creed, national origin or enlisted military grade.

2. Eligible Air Force widows in need of financial relief are given first priority for admission.

Admissions

The following forms can be downloaded from our website and must be submitted with required documentation for an applicant to be considered for admission:

1. Admission Application
2. Medical Information

Required Documentation:

1. Marriage Certificate
2. Proof of Retirement (Orders or DD-214)
3. Spouse's Birth Certificate
4. Sponsor's Death Certificate (if applicable)
5. Financial Affidavit (AFEV Form available from the Admissions Office if requesting subsidy.)

Eligibility Criteria

All applicants MUST BE ambulatory, able to carry on daily activities without assistance and possess a valid military identification card. Those eligible for residence are:

- Any widow, widower, or dependent age 55 or older of an Air Force, Air National Guard, or Air Force Reserve career enlisted member receiving full retirement benefits.

- Any widow, widower, or dependent age 55 or older of an enlisted member who died while on active duty with the regular Air Force, Air National Guard, or Air Force Reserve.

- In the event of the death of the Active Duty Air Force sponsor, or Air Force Guard or Air Force Reserve sponsor on active duty,

any widow, widower, or dependent under age 55 may be admitted for a maximum of one year to meet emergency needs.

- Any retired couple of the Air Force, Air National Guard, or Air Force Reserve when the retired member is age 55 or older and the spouse is age 55 or older.

- Other service widows meeting eligibility criteria on a space-available basis. No subsidy available.

Admittance Priority

First - Dire Need: Any eligible AF widow with an immediate need for financial relief.

Second - Widow: Any eligible widow or dependent parents of active duty or retired members. Placed on Widows' Waiting List in order of completed application date.

Third - Couple: Any eligible AF couple. Placed on Couples' Waiting List in order of completed application date.

Basic Information

- The first and final month's service fees and a non-refundable admission fee is due upon admission. Fees are periodically adjusted to meet inflation costs.

- Service fee subsidy is available for qualifying Air Force widows needing assistance.

- Tours of the facilities are conducted Monday through Friday during business hours. Special tours during non-business hours and for large groups can be arranged with advance notice.

- Pets are not permitted.

- Children are not permitted to reside in AFEV facilities. Children may visit residents; however, they are the responsibility of the resident.

- Overnight visitors are limited to 14 days per calendar year.

- Apartment residents pay for electricity, telephone, and premium cable TV service.

- Bob Hope and Teresa Villages are smoke-free retirement communities. Residents and guests are not permitted to smoke in the villages, except in designated smoking areas.

Amenities

- Transportation is available for all residents. Regular trips are made to the hospital, base exchange, commissary and local shopping centers.

- Contracted security agency for Teresa Village and Bob Hope Village.

- Maintenance inside and outside of apartments is provided.

- Garden plots are available.

- Swimming pools and recreation areas are located at both Villages.

- Water, sewer and garbage service as well as basic cable TV service is paid by the Village. House residents pay all utilities.

- Basic kitchen appliances; central air and heat; carpeting and free laundry facilities provided.

Facilities

Teresa Village, 321 Woodrow St., Fort Walton Beach, FL 32547

Capacity: 101 two-bedroom first and second floor apartments; eight one-bedroom first floor apartments and seven houses. There are no elevators. The Teresa Village Community Center is 4,920 square feet and houses a dining room and kitchen; arts and crafts room; game room; library and chapel. There is also an outdoor swimming pool.
